TREE & SHRUB PLANTING TIPS

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FIRST STEP = WATER YOUR PLANTS!

It's very important to **WATER** your new plants **BEFORE** you plant them!

BAREROOT TREES & SHRUBS **CONTAINER TREES** & SHRUBS Plastic or Rubber Stake only as high as necessary to prevent Tree Ties 2 to 3 Times the Diameter of Roots leaning (optional) in "Figure Eight" Mulch 2" to 3" with *Bark*. Earth Black Forest Compost. Watering or Cocoa Hulls Basin Water in with Finish Grade Root Master B-1 Rootball slightly higher Loosened than Finish Grade to Root Ball allow for settling Fertilizer with ½ the Height **Master Start** or of Root Ball Garden Elements Organic Starter Amend soil backfill with

½ the Height of Roots

BALLED & BURLAPPED (B&B)

- Dig & amend hole as for container plants
- Place burlap-covered root ball in hole
- Cut & loosen rope from around the trunk
- Do not loosen the root ball
- The burlap will rot away
- All other planting tips apply

These **Planting Tips** outline the steps you should take to get your new plant off to a great start.

The insets for **Bareroot** and B&B Trees & **Shrubs** show what might be a little different for these plants.
